X/4 C/S -- BULGARIAN TROOPS TRANSPORTED BY AIR TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA

MUNICH, AUG. 27 (CMD)-RADIO WARSAW CORRESPONDENT IN SOFIA SAID LAST NIGHT THAT THE BULGARIAN INVASION TROOPS WERE TRANSPORTED BY AIR TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE CORRESPONDENT SAID:

"THE BULGARIAN NATION AND ITS ARMY, WHOSE UNITS HAVE BEEN TRANSPORTED BY AIR TO THE TERRITORY OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC, FULLY SUPPORT THE DECISION OF THE PARTY LEADERSHIP AND THE BULGARIAN GOVERNMENT, AS WELL AS THAT OF THE REMAINING FOUR SOCIALIST COUNTRIES CONCERNING THE ASSISTANCE FOR THE DEFENCE OF THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF SOCIALISM IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA," SAID THE CORRESPONDENT.

THE CORRESPONDENT SAID THAT THIS SUPPORT WAS SHOWN BY WORKING PEOPLE IN BULGARIA AT HUNDREDS OF GATHERINGS AND MEETINGS WHICH WERE HELD ALL OVER THE COUNTRY.

THE CORRESPONDENT SAID THAT ABOUT 10,000 CZECHOSLOVAK TOURISTS WERE NOW STAYING IN BULGARIA, AND WAITING TO RETURN HOME.

THE BULGARIAN AUTHORITIES HAVE GIVEN THEM ASSISTANCE, HE SAID.
