(CMD) - ACCORDING TO RADIO BELGRADE VICTOR SHRAGIN ACCUSED YUGOSLAV AND RUMANIAN LEADERS OF 'HAVING JOINED THE IMPERIALIST CHOIR WHICH IS CONDEMNING THE ACTION OF THE FIVE (WARSAW PACT) COUNTRIES IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA' AND OF SUPPORTING THE ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, WHICH WAS SHOWN BY THE INTENTION TO FORM A CZECHOSLOVAK EMIGREE GOVERNMENT IN BELGRADE.

ACCORDING TO THE RADIO, SHRAGIN ALSO REMEMBERED THAT YUGOSLAVIA AND RUMANIA ALREADY HAD THEIR OWN POSITION AS FOR INSTANCE, IN THE CASE OF THE LEAGUE OF YUGOSLAV COMMUNISTS WHICH DID NOT RPT NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE BUDAPEST CONSULTATIVE MEETING HELD LAST MARCH. HE ALSO ACCUSED THE RUMANIAN COMMUNIST PARTY OF HAVING HAD THE INTENTION TO HAMPER THAT (BUDAPEST) MEETING. (RADIO BELGRADE, DOMESTIC/M, AUGUST 26, 2200, 1968)
