SIK ACCEPTS 25-NATION DECLARATION

BELGRADE, AUG. 27 (UPI)-CZECHOSLOVAK DEPUTY PREMIER OTA SIK HAS RECEIVED A DECLARATION FROM PEACE ORGANIZATIONS IN 25 COUNTRIES CONDEMNING THE SOVIET INTERVENTION.

THE DECLARATION WAS PRESENTED TO SIK IN BELGRADE BY A DELEGATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONFEDERATION FOR DISARMAMENT AND PEACE. THE DOCUMENT LABELLED CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S OCCUPATION AN "ACT OF AGGRESSION".

IT ALSO DEMANDED THE "IMMEDIATE RELEASE " OF ALL ARRESTED CZECHOSLOVAK OFFICIALS AND THE "IMMEDIATE AND UNCONDITIONAL WITHDRAWAL" OF ALL OCCUPATION FORCES FROM CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

INVASION PROTEST WILL STOP AUSTRIAS TRAFFIC ON TUESDAY

VIENNA, AUG 27 (RFE SPECIAL/KOSTRBA) -- IN PROTEST OF THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, STREET TRAFFIC IS TO STOP ON TUESDAY FOR FIVE MINUTES IN AUSTRIA, THE AUSTRIAN TRADE UNION FEDERATION ANNOUNCED.

ORIGINALLY, THE AUSTRIAN TRADE UNION FEDERATION HAD APPEALED ONLY TO TRUCK, BUS AND MUNICIPAL TRANSPORT DRIVERS TO DEMONSTRATE THEIR SOLIDARITY WITH THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE BY STOPPING CIRCULATION FROM 1155 TO 1200 (MT) ON TUESDAY.

BOTH AUSTRIAN AUTOMOBILE CLUBS, THE (NON-PARTY) OEAMTC AND THE SOCIALIST ARBOE FOLLOWED SUIT AND APPEALED TO ALL AUSTRIAN MOTORISTS TO JOIN THE TRADE UNIONS ACTION IN ORDER TO PROTEST AGAINST THE MILITARY OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.
