X/4 C/S - 1ST ADD -- WARSAW: INVASION WAS DIFFICULT...(CN 42) XXX SAID.

THE POLISH PARTY PAPER, TRYBUNA LUDU, SAID YESTERDAY THAT THE SOLUTION OF THE PRESENT CRISIS MUST BE BASED ON THE CERTAINTY THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK FRONTIERS WHICH "IN THE WEST CONSTITUTE THE FRONTIER OF THE WHOLE SOCIALIST COMMUNITY, WILL BE FULLY SECURED. THIS CERTAINTY CAN BE ONLY CREATED BY THE PRESENCE OF THE WARSAW PACT ARMIES ALONG THE WHOLE WESTERN FRONTIER OF OUR CAMP, AND THUS ALSO ON THE FRONTIER BETWEEN THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC AND THE GERMAN FEDERAL REPUBLIC", SAID THE PAPER.

RADIO WARSAW COMMENTATOR MIECZYSLAW KOFTA ALSO STRESSED LAST NIGHT THE NECESSITY OF SECURING FULLY THE CZECHOSLOVAK FRONTIER.

ANOTHER RADIO WARSAW COMMENTATOR, JAN ZAKRZEWSKI SAID LAST NIGHT THAT THE AIM OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK-SOVIET TALKS IN MOSCOW SEEMED TO BE CLEAR AT THE MOMENT. "THE QUESTION IS TO FIND SUCH A SOLUTION IN WHICH THE WESTERN FRONTIER OF THE SOCIALIST CAMP WAS PROPERLY SECURED IN FRONT OF WEST GERMAN REVISIONISM AND MILITARISM....," HE SAID.
