

WORLD -- THE DAY AHEAD

MUNICH, AUG 27 (CNR)-THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY SOVIET-LED WARSAW PACT FORCES IS STILL THE WORLD'S TOP NEWS STORY TODAY.

AND THE OUTCOME OF CRUCIAL TALKS IN MOSCOW BETWEEN THE CZECHOSLOVAK AND SOVIET LEADERS REMAINS THE LEADING DEVELOPMENT.

THE MOSCOW TALKS -- NOW IN THEIR FIFTH DAY - - ARE GOING ON AS OCCUPATION FORCES TIGHTEN THEIR CONTROL ON CZECHOSLOVAK AFFAIRS.

BUT THERE ARE CLANDESTINE RADIO REPORTS THAT DESPITE THE OCCUPATION THE SLOVAK NATIONAL CONGRESS HAS BEGAN IN A SECRET AND THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK CENTRAL COMMITTEE WILL MEET TODAY TO DISCUSS THE PRESENT SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY.

MEANWHILE, REPLIES ARE AWAITED FROM RUMANIA AND YUGOSLAVIA FOLLOWING NEW SOVIET ATTACKS ON THEM FOR THEIR HOSTILE REACTION TO THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

PROTESTS AGAINST THE OCCUPATION CONTINUE AROUND THE WORLD AND MORE ARE EXPECTED TODAY.

TODAY'S OTHER MAJOR NEWS IS EXPECTED TO CENTRE ON THE AMERICAN DEMOCRATIC PARTY'S NATIONAL CONVENTION WHICH OPENED IN CHICAGO EARLIER THIS MORNING.
