

X/4 C/S - MORNING INTRO - CEAUSESCU

MUNICH, AUG 27 (CMD)--RUMANIAN COMMUNIST PARTY LEADER NICOLAE CEAUSESCU HAS SAID HE HOPED THAT THE MOSCOW TALKS WOULD REACH AGREEMENT ALLOWING FOREIGN TROOPS TO LEAVE CZECHOSLOVAKIA IMMEDIATELY .

CEAUSESCU DISCUSSED CZECHOSLOVAK EVENTS YESTERDAY AT RALLIES AT BRASOV, MIERCUREA CIUC, AND ODORHEIUL SECUIESC.

SPEAKING AT ODORHEIUL SECUIESC, CEAUSESCU SAID HE HOPED THAT THE MOSCOW TALKS "WOULD FIND A SOLUTION ALLOWING THE TROOPS WHICH ENTERED CZECHOSLOVAK TERRITORY WITHOUT BEING INVITED, TO BE WITHDRAWN IMMEDIATELY IN ORDER TO GUARANTEE THE FULL INDEPENDENCE AND SOVEREIGNTY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

HE ADDED: "WE WANT TO DEVELOP GOOD RELATIONS WITH THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES, WE WANT NOBODY TO HARM THE FRATERNAL COLLABORATION RELATIONS, BUT WE WANT TO BE LEFT ALONE TO SOLVE OUR PROBLEMS AS WE CONSIDER IT NECESSARY. WE ALSO WANT OTHER PEOPLES TO BE LEFT ALONE TO SOLVE THEIR PROBLEMS LIKE THEY WANT."

CEAUSESCU SAID THAT MATTERS IN AN INDIVIDUAL COUNTRY SHOULD BE DECIDED BY THE WORKERS PEASANTS AND INTELLECTUALS HEADED BY THE COMMUNIST PARTY.

"WE WANT TO HAVE THE POSSIBILITY TO JUDGE WHAT IS GOOD AND WHAT IS WRONG BECAUSE WE CONSIDER THAT THE WORKERS, PEASANTS AND INTELLECTUALS OF RUMANIA KNOW BETTER IF GOOD RESULTS ARE OBTAINED IN A FIELD OR ANOTHER OF OUR SOCIAL ACTIVITY.

"THIS IS WHY WE WERE DEEPLY CONCERNED BY THE ENTRY OF THE TROOPS OF FIVE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES INTO CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND WE APPRECIATE THIS IS NOT RPT NOT AID BUT IS HAMPERING THE PEACEFUL WORK OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE IN THE SOCIALIST CONSTRUCTION."
