(CMD) - RADIO CENTRAL BOHEMIA SAID THE DELEGATION WAS LED BY PRESIDENT LUDVIK SVOBODA.

THE RADIO SAID, INTERRUPTING A PROGRAM:

"OUR CZECHOSLOVAK DELEGATION ARRIVED BY PLANE FROM THE TALKS IN MOSCOW IN THE EARLY MORNING HOURS.

"IT (THE DELEGATION) LEFT, HEADED BY PRESIDENT LUDVIK SVOBODA, FOR PRAGUE CASTLE."

"TOGETHER WITH THE PRESIDENT ALSO ARRIVED: COMRADES (ALEXANDER) DUBCEK, (JOSEF) SMRKOVSKY, (OLDRICH) CERNIK, (FRANTISEK) KRIEGL, (JOSEF) SPACEK AND (BOHUMIL) SIMON."

"WITH TENSION WE ARE AWAITING FURTHER REPORTS FROM THE CASTLE.

"AND ONE MORE FLASH: TODAY, IN EARLY MORNING HOURS, SOVIET SOLDIERS LEFT WITH TANKS THE SQUARE OF MAXIM GORKI. THE BUILDING OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY IS, FOR THE FIRST TIME DURING THE SIX DAYS OF THE OCCUPATION, WITHOUT THE PRESENCE OR CLOSE PRESENCE OF THE OCCUPATION TROOPS."
