

C/S - CERNIK ADDRESS GOVERNMENT MEETING

MUNICH, AUG 27 (CNR) - PREMIER OLDRICH CERNIK OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA HAS ADDRESSED AN EXTRAORDINARY GOVERNMENT MEETING IN PRAGUE, ACCORDING TO WESTERN NEWS AGENCY REPORTS FROM LONDON AND VIENNA QUOTING AUTHORITATIVE REPORTS FROM CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE AGENCY SOURCES SAID THAT THE PREMIER CALLED HIS GOVERNMENT INTO OFFICE A FEW HOURS AFTER HE RETURNED FROM MOSCOW WITH OTHER CZECHOSLOVAK LEADERS.

THE EXTRAORDINARY MEETING WAS AT HRADCANY CASTLE IN PRAGUE AT 0500 M.T. THE SOURCES QUOTED BY THE AGENCIES SAID.

THE SOURCES ADDED THAT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE GOVERNMENT WAS CALLED BY CERNIK FOR 1000 M.T. THERE HAS NOT RPT NOT BEEN ANY NEWS YET AS TO WHETHER THIS MEETING BEGAN AS SCHEDULED.

AGENCE FRANCE PRESS REPORTED FROM PRAGUE THAT ACCORDING TO A CENTRAL COMMITTEE STATEMENT ISSUED IN PRAGUE THE DELEGATION WHICH RETURNED FROM MOSCOW IS MEETING WITH THE GOVERNMENT AND THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY PRESIDUM TO DISCUSS THE RESULTS OF THE MOSCOW TALKS.
