"ACCORDING TO THE WORDS OF PRESIDENT TITO ACCORDING TO HIS SPEECH AT THE PARTY'S CENTRAL COMMITTEE, THE STEP OF THE FIVE COUNTRIES EVOLVED FROM THE VIEW THAT THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE WARSAW TREATY MAKES IT IMPOSSIBLE FOR A COUNTRY TO FOLLOW ITS OWN ROAD.

"BUT HE (TITO) DID NOT RPT NOT DEFINE MORE CLOSELY WHAT ONE SHOULD UNDERSTAND BY THE CONCEPT OF OWN ROAD," THE RADIO SAID.

"ONE SHOULD NOT BLAME US IF WE CONSIDERED THE SIMILARITY BETWEEN THE PRESENT YUGOSLAV STANDPOINT AND THAT OF THE HUNGARIAN COUNTER-REVOLUTION.

"AT THAT TIME THEY ALSO DEALT ONLY WITH THE LEFTIST DANGER AND DID NOT ACT AGAINST THE RIGHTIST ONE AND DID NOT DISTINGUISH BETWEEN THE FOLLOWERS AND ENEMIES OF SOCIALISM," THE RADIO SAID.
