

NOVISAD: OCCUPATION UNPARDONABLE DISGRACE

MUNICH, AUGUST 27 (CMD)- YUGOSLAV RADIO NOVISAD SAID IN A HUNGARIAN LANGUAGE BROADCAST YESTERDAY THAT THE ARMED OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA WILL REMAIN AN UNPARDONABLE DISGRACE.

COMMENTATOR ANDRAS MADARASZ SAID "I CANNOT FIND ANY SUCH EVENT WHICH SHOCKED AND EMBITTERED THE PEOPLE OF YUGOSLAVIA AS MUCH AS THE MILITARY OCCUPATION OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC AND THE ATTEMPT TO HINDER ITS PARTICULAR SOCIALIST DEVELOPMENT."

HE SAID PROTEST IS MIXED WITH GRIEF BECAUSE "NOT A CLASS ENEMY, NOT THE ARMED FORCES OF CAPITALISM BROKE INTO THE SOCIALIST CONSTRUCTION WORK OF A PEOPLE BUT THOSE WHO WERE CONSIDERED BY US COMRADES IN BUILDING A MORE REAL SOCIAL ORDER AND WHO, AND THIS IS THE IRONY OF FATE, ARE CALLING THEMSELVES COMRADES EVEN IN THIS ACTION (OCCUPATION)."

"AND, AT THE SAME TIME, THEY TURNED AGAINST THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE STRUGGLING FOR THE IDEAS OF THE RED FLAG, FOR FREE, DEMOCRATIC CONDITIONS WITH RED FLAGS (IN THEIR HANDS)," MADARASZ SAID.

"THE FACT OF THE MILITARY OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA WILL BE RECORDED AS AN UNPARDONABLE MISTAKE AND DISGRACE IN THE HISTORY OF SOCIALIST COUNTRIES AND THE INTERNATIONAL WORKER'S MOVEMENT," HE SAID.

RUMANIAN WRITERS VOICE SOLIDARITY WITH CZECHOSLOVAKS  
MUNICH, AUG 27 (CMD)- RUMANIAN WRITERS HAVE VOICED SOLIDARITY WITH THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE AND EXPRESSED THEIR HOPE THAT THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA WILL HAVE A "CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTION."

RADIO BUCHAREST REPORTED TODAY THAT A DECLARATION PUBLISHED BY THE RUMANIAN WRITERS UNION, /EXPRESSES DEEP SYMPATHY AND INTERNATIONALIST SOLIDARITY WITH THE FRATERNAL CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE AND ITS HOPE THAT THE SITUATION CREATED IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA MAY BE SOLVED POSITIVELY AND CONSTRUCTIVELY IN THE INTEREST OF SOCIALIST CONSTRUCTION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, OF THE UNITY OF THE WORLD SOCIALIST SYSTEM, OF THE CAUSE OF SOCIALISM IN THE ENTIRE WORLD."

THE RADIO SAID THE DECLARATION "EXPRESSES FULL ADHESION TO THE (AUG 22, 1968) RUMANIAN PARLIAMENT DECLARATION CONCERNING THE BASIC PRINCIPLES OF OUR COUNTRY'S FOREIGN POLICY.

"RUMANIAN WRITERS," THE DECLARATION SAID, "SUPPORT WITH ALL THEIR STRENGTH THE EFFORTS OF OUR PARTY AND SOCIALIST STATE FOR STRENGTHENING FRIENDSHIP AND COLLABORATION AMONG THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES AND THE UNITY OF THE WORLD SOCIALIST SYSTEM, FOR CONSOLIDATING THE COHESION OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNIST AND WORKERS MOVEMENT."

PROBLEMS ARISING AMONG SOCIALIST COUNTRIES AND COMMUNIST PARTIES CAN BE SOLVED SUCCESSFULLY ONLY BY "COMRADELY DISCUSSIONS IN AN ATMOSPHERE OF MUTUAL ESTEEM AND CONFIDENCE," THE DECLARATION SAID.
