X/4 C/S - BORDERS REOPENED TO CS PEOPLE

MUNICH, AUG 27 (CMD) -- CROSSING POINTS ON HUNGARIAN CZECHOSLOVAK BORDERS HAVE BEEN REOPENED TO TRAFFIC FOR CZECHOSLOVAKS RETURNING TO THEIR COUNTRY, RADIO ZAGREB SAID THIS MORNING.

THE HUNGARIAN FOREIGN MINISTRY CONFIRMED TO THE YUGOSLAV EMBASSY IN BUDAPEST AT THE RAILROAD CROSSING POINT OF SHOBOVO-STRUHOVO AS WELL AS ALL HIGHWAY CROSSING POINTS EAST OF SHOBOVO HAVE BEEN REOPENED TO TRAFFIC FOR CZECHOSLOVAKS RETURNING HOME.

THE RADIO SAID THAT, AS THE YUGOSLAV FOREIGN SECRETARIAT HAS ANNOUNCED, AGREEMENT HAS BEEN REACHED BETWEEN THE CZECHOSLOVAK

EMBASSY IN VIENNA AND AUSTRIAN AUTHORITIES TO GRANT AUSTRIAN VISAS TO CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS ON THE AUSTRIAN-YUGOSLAV BORDERS.
