THE RADIO COMMENTATOR CONTINUED:

"WE KNOW THAT THESE WERE IMMENSELY DIFFICULT TALKS IN MOSCOW. WE DO NOT RPT NOT HAVE THE SLIGHTEST ILLUSIONS AS TO WHAT ATMOSPHERE YOU HAD TO HOLD TALKS IN, UNDER WHICH CONDITIONS, BUT I THINK THAT I CAN SAY ON BEHALF OF THE PUBLIC THAT WE ARE ABLE TO UNDERSTAND THAT.

"WE CAN ALSO UNDERSTAND THAT THE NEXT DAYS WILL BE DIFFICULT, BUT WE WILL STAND THEM.

"BECAUSE THIS NATION HAS EXPERIENCE AS TO WHAT IT SHOULD DO IN ORDER TO STAND ON ITS OWN FEET."

THE RADIO ANNOUNCER WENT ON SAYING:

"I THINK THAT THE GREATEST PLEASURE FOR YOU, WHO WERE CUT OFF FROM YOUR HOME, IS THAT IT IS THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY WHICH DIRECTS THE POLITICAL WORK HERE, FOR THE 7TH DAY, AND REALLY IN ALL TOWNS AND VILLAGES."

"UNDER INCREDIBLY DIFFICULT CONDITIONS, AND STILL THE GOVERNMENT AND PARLIAMENTARY ORGANS ARE WORKING."

"I WOULD ALSO SAY THAT THE FRIENDSHIP OF CZECHS AND SLOVAKS DEMONSTRATES THAT THE DEVELOPMENT OF THIS REPUBLIC, WHEN THE DAYS OF FREEDOM WILL COME AGAIN, WILL BE CREATED BY TWO NATIONS THE COHESION OF WHICH CAN BE ENVIED BY ANY SEVERAL NEIGHBORING COUNTRIES.

"THE SLOGANS IN PRAGUE HAVE GROWN IN NUMBER AGAIN. EACH BANNER WHICH WAS TORN OFF BY THE HAND OF THE OCCUPIERS, WAS REPLACED BY DOZENS OF OTHERS.

"WHAT BRINGS OUR OCCUPIERS TO DESPAIR IS OUR PERSISTANCE, CLEVERNESS AND WITTINESS."
