X/4 C/S --2ND ADD COMMUNIQUE ON TROOPS (CN 161) XXX COMMUNITY

THE COMMUNIQUE ALSO SAID THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK SIDE SAID IT "HAD NOT RPT NOT REQUESTED" THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK SITUATION BE DISCUSSED BY THE U.N. SECURITY

COUNCIL AND HAD DEMANDED ITS REMOVAL FROM THE AGENDA.

ACCORDING TO THE COMMUNIQUE, THE CZECHOSLOVAK DELEGATION "INFORMED THE SOVIET SIDE THAT THE SUPREME COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK ARMED FORCES HAD GIVEN THE LATTER APPROPRIATE ORDERS WITH THE AIM OF PREVENTING INCIDENTS AND CONFLICTS CAPABLE OF VIOLATING PEACE AND PUBLIC ORDER."

"HE HAD ALSO," THE COMMUNIQUE ADDED," INSTRUCTED THE MILITARY COMMAND OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC TO BE IN CONTACT WITH THE COMMAND OF THE ALLIED TROOPS."
