C/S - 4TH ADD COMMUNIQUE (CN 166) XXX MUNITY

EXPRESSING THE UNANIMOUS STRIVING OF THE PEOPLES OF THE USSR FOR FRIENDSHIP AND BROTHERHOOD WITH THE PEOPLES OF SOCIALIST CZECHOSLOVAKIA, THE SOVIET LEADERS CONFIRMED THEIR READINESS FOR THE BROADEST SINCERE COOPERATION ON THE BASIS OF MUTUAL RESPECT, EQUALITY, TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY, INDEPENDENCE AND SOCIALIST SOLIDARITY.

THE TROOPS OF THE ALLIED COUNTRIES, THAT ENTERED TEMPORARILY THE TERRITORY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, WILL NOT RPT NOT INTERFERE IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC. AGREEMENT WAS REACHED ON THE TERMS OF THE WITHDRAWAL OF THESE TROOPS FROM ITS TERRITORY AS THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA NORMALISES.

THE CZECHOSLOVAK SIDE INFORMED THE SOVIET SIDE THAT THE SUPREME COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK ARMED FORCES HAD GIVEN THE LATTER APPROPRIATE ORDERS WITH THE AIM OF PREVENTING INCIDENTS AND CONFLICTS CAPABLE OF VIOLATING THE PEACE AND PUBLIC ORDER. HE HAD ALSO INSTRUCTED THE MILITARY COMMAND OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC TO BE IN CONTACT WITH THE COMMAND OF THE ALLIED TROOPS.
