X/4 C/S -- DUBCEK TO PARTICIPATE IN SLOVAK PARTY CONGRESS

MUNICH, AUG 27 -- (CMD) -- RADIO "TOWN OF CORN" OF SLOVAKIA SAID IN ITS HUNGARIAN BROADCAST TODAY THAT CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY LEADER ALEXANDER DUBCEK WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE PRESENT EXTRAORDINARY SLOVAK PARTY CONGRESS.

THE RADIO SAID THAT THE PEOPLE OF SOUTHERN SLOVAKIA AND "THE HUNGARIANS OF OUR FATHERLAND" WELCOMED WITH "WARM ATTACHMENT" THE LEADERS OF THE COUNTRY AND GOVERNMENT WHO "AFTER SEVERAL DAYS OF MOSCOW DISCUSSIONS RETURNED TO PRAGUE AT LAST."

THE RADIO SAID THE SLOVAK PARTY CONGRESS BEGAN DURING THE NIGHT AND UNANIMOUSLY AGREED TO THE DECISIONS MADE BY THE 14TH EXTRAORDINARY CONGRESS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY AS WELL AS THE APPEAL TO PARTIES OF THE "FIVE OCCUPATION COUNTRIES."

IT SAID THE EXTRAORDINARY CONGRESS CONTINUED ITS WORK TODAY AND 85 TO 90 PER CENT OF THE DELEGATES HAVE PARTICIPATED IT.

CONGRESS CHAIRMAN VIKTOR PAVLENDI ANNOUNCED THAT HE CONTRACTED DEPUTY PREMIER GUSTAV HUSAK WHO RETURNED FROM MOSCOW AFTER SOVIET CZECHOSLOVAK TALKS.

HUSAK ASKED THAT THE DISCUSSION OF PROCEDURAL QUESTIONS SHOULD BE DELAYED BY A FEW HOURS BECAUSE HUSAK AND CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY LEADER ALEXANDER DUBCEK "WILL PERSONALLY PARTICIPATE IN THE CONGRESS," THE RADIO ADDED. (RADIO TOWN OF CORN IN HUNGARIAN/M AUG 27, 1130)
