WEST GERMAN WORKERS STOP IN SYMPATHY

NUREMBERG, AUG 27 (DPA/GND) - THREE HUNDRED WORKERS AT THE A.E.G. ELECTRICAL FACTORY IN NUREMBERG STOPPED WORK FOR FIVE MINUTES AT NOON TODAY AS A PROTEST AGAINST THE EVENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE CHAIRMAN OF THE WORKS COUNCIL STATED THAT THE ACTION WAS COMPLETELY SPONTANEOUS AND WAS ORGANISED NEITHER BY THE MANAGEMENT NOR BY THE TRADE UNIONS.

RAW MATERIALS FROM CSSR AGAIN

SELB, BAVARIA, AUG 27 (DPA/GND) - WEST GERMAN LORRIES CARRYING RAW MATERIALS FROM THE KARLOVY VARY AREA FOR THE CERAMIC, CHEMICAL AND PAPER INDUSTRIES CAN AGAIN RESUME DELIVERIES OVER THE BORDER CROSSING-POINT OF SCHIRDNING.

THIS ARRANGEMENT WAS MADE TODAY BY THE GENERAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK CERAMIC FOREIGN TRADE ENTERPRISE IN PRAGUE, WERNER FUERST, IN NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE CZECHOSLOVAK BORDER AUTHORITIES.

ABOUT 140,000 TONS OF RAW MATERIALS FOR THESE INDUSTRIES ARE EXPORTED TO THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC ANNUALLY.
