X/13 CS - RUMANIANS RESTRICT REPORTING ON CSSR

BUCHAREST, AUGUST 27 (DPA/GND)- RUMANIAN REPORTING ON THE SITUATION IN OCCUPIED CZECHOSLOVAKIA WAS FURTHER RESTRICTED TODAY.

THE PARTY NEWSPAPER SCINTEIA PUBLISHED NOTHING ABOUT DEVELOPMENTS IN THE CSSR OR ABOUT THE MOSCOW TALKS.

RADIO AND TELEVISION REPORTING WAS ALSO GREATLY REDUCED.

THE NEWSPAPERS REPORTED AT LENGTH ON THE OTHER HAND ON THE TRIP BY THE PARTY AND GOVERNMENT LEADERS THROUGH TRANSYLVANIA AND THE SPEECHES THEY MADE THERE.

IN SCINTEIA THESE REPORTS OCCUPY ALMOST SIX PAGES.

IN ITS VERSION OF THE SPEECHES BY PARTY LEADER NIVOLAE CEAUSESCU, THE OFFICIAL NEWS AGENCY AGERPRES OMITTED THE PASSAGES DEALING WITH THE NECESSITY OF A WITHDRAWAL OF THE TROOPS FROM CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

HOWEVER, SCINTEIA DISCLOSES THAT CEAUSESCU CALLED FOR A WITHDRAWAL OF THE WARSAW PACT TROOPS IN AT LEAST TWO SPEECHES WHICH HE MADE IN TRANSYLVANIAN TOWNS ON MONDAY.
