

MUNICH, AUG 27 (CNR) - PRESIDENT LUDVIK SVOBODA PLEDGED IN A RADIO BROADCAST TODAY THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY WOULD "NOT RPT NOT RETREAT ONE INCH" FROM ITS INTENTIONS.

"OF COURSE", HE ADDED, "WE SHALL NOT PERMIT THAT THEY BE ABUSED FOR THEIR OWN PURPOSES BY THOSE WHOM THE AIMS OF SOCIALISM ARE ALIEN."

HE SAID THE PARTY WANTED TO FURTHER DEVELOP THE SOCIALIST ORDER IN THE SPIRIT OF THE JANUARY, APRIL AND MAY PLENUMS OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE.

"WE WANT FURTHER TO DEVELOP THE SOCIALIST SOCIAL ORDER AND TO STRENGTHEN ITS HUMANIST DEMOCRATIC CHARACTER," HE SAID IN HIS FIRST SPEECH TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE SINCE RETURNING FROM MOSCOW.

"THE POSITION OF OUR COUNTRY IN THE PRESENT DAY WORLD IS AND CANNOT BE ELSEWHERE BUT IN THE SOCIALIST COMMUNITY," PRESIDENT SVOBODA SAID.

IN A REFERENCE TO THE AGREEMENT REACHED IN MOSCOW, HE SAID HE HAD RETURNED FROM THE SOVIET CAPITAL "WITH ALL THOSE COMRADES" WHO HAD RESUMED THEIR DEMOCRATICALLY-APPOINTED DUTIES.

"THIS IS THE FIRST, AND AT LEAST FOR US AN IMPORTANT, STEP TOWARD A NORMALIZATION OF LIFE IN OUR HOMELAND."

THE PRESIDENT WENT ON TO SAY THAT THE DEPARTURE OF THE OCCUPYING FORCES "IS CONNECTED WITH THIS.

"IN PARTICULAR, WE HAVE REACHED AGREEMENT ON THE GRADUAL IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL OF THESE FORCES, UNTIL SUCH A TIME, THEIR PRESENCE IS A POLITICAL REALITY."
