C/S -- HUNGARIANS RE-OPEN BORDERS (RELEADS CN 155)

BUDAPEST, AUG. 27, REUTER--HUNGARY HAS REOPENED ITS BORDERS, CLOSED SHORTLY AFTER THE WARSAW PACT INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA LAST WEEK, TO FOREIGN TOURISTS LEAVING THE COUNTRY, THE HUNGARIAN NEWS AGENCY MTI REPORTED TODAY.

TOURISTS TRAPPED IN THE COUNTRY WERE ACCOMMODATED IN SEVERAL HOLIDAY CAMPS DURING THE CLOSURE.

MTI ADDED THAT THE REGULAR TRAIN SERVICE FROM BUDAPEST TO AUSTRIA, RUMANIA AND YUGOSLAVIA HAD BEEN RESUMED AND WAS RUNNING TO SCHEDULE.

A HUNGARIAN EMBASSY SPOKESMAN SAID FOREIGNERS WERE ALSO ALLOWED INTO THE COUNTRY AGAIN.
