X/13 E/W -- PHILOSOPHY CONGRESS IN SHADOW OF CS EVENTS

VIENNA, AUG 27 (RFE SPECIAL/KOCH)-- A PROPOSED TELEVISION ROUND TABLE WITH PHILOSOPHERS FROM EAST AND WEST WILL BE TAPED BY THE AUSTRIAN BROADCASTING CORPORATION THOUGH THERE IS DOUBT THAT SOME EAST EUROPEAN PARTICIPANTS WILL BE ABLE TO ATTEND AS THE RESULT OF THE EVENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, THE "ABC" ANNOUNCED TODAY (TUESDAY) IN VIENNA.

THE TELEVISION PROGRAM IS SCHEDULED TO BE TAPED THIS SATURDAY AND SHOWN ON SUNDAY AT 2140 HOURS, ONE DAY BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF THE MAMMOTH "14TH INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS ON PHILOSOPHY" WHICH IS EXPECTED TO BE ATTENDED BY MORE THAN 2,000 PHILOSOPHERS FROM EAST AND WEST.

INVITED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TELEVIZED PROGRAM WHICH IS TITLED "PHILOSOPHY IN THE AGE OF SCIENCE" ARE PROFESSORS ADAM SCHAFF (POLAND) -- HANS GEORG GADAMER (WEST GERMANY) -- JAN PATOCKA (CZECHOSLOVAKIA) -- LASZLO MATRAI (HUNGARY) -- VLADIMIR FILIPOVICE (YUGOSLAVIA) -- IGOR S. NARSKI (USSR) -- RAYMOND KLIBANSKY (CANADA) -- MARINO GENTILE (ITALY) -- CHAIM PERLEMAN (BELGIUM) -- P. T. PAJU (USA) AND KENJI FUJITA (JAPAN), AND SIR KARL POPPER OF ENGLAND.

ORIGINALLY PLANNED FOR THE CONGRESS PARTICIPANTS AT THE END OF THE SESSIONS WERE TRIPS TO THE SOVIET UNION AND CZECHOSLOVAKIA, WHICH NOW APPEAR TO STAND IN DOUBT ALSO.
