

SOCIALISM, DUBCEK SAID, WOULD BE DEVELOPED IN SUCH A WAY AS WAS FORMULATED AT THE JANUARY PLENUM.

"IT IS ESSENTIAL," HE CONTINUED, "THAT WE NOT RPT NOT GIVE UP OUR EFFORTS TO IMPLEMENT OUR HUMANISTIC PRINCIPLES. EVEN THEN, WE MUST HAVE STRENGTH AND STRENGTH IS ONLY IN UNITY."

HE WARNED THIS WOULD NOT RPT NOT BE EASY AND IT WOULD BE NECESSARY TO MAKE MANY EFFORTS AND "WE SHOULD AVOID ACTIONS OF ADVENTURE AND ANARCHY."

HE SAID: "WE BELIEVE THE NEW SITUATION IN OUR COUNTRY PUTS BEFORE US NEW QUESTIONS AND NEW DEMANDS ... THE FIRST THING WE NEED IS TO CONSOLIDATE THE SITUATION ... THIS WILL BE VERY COMPLEX BUT IT IS BASIC TO FURTHER STEPS."

DUBCEK ADDED:

"WE WILL HAVE TO TAKE SOME TEMPORARY MEASURES WHICH WILL REDUCE THE DEGREE OF DEMOCRACY WHICH WE ALREADY HAVE BUT I BEG YOU TO REALIZE THE TIME WE ARE LIVING IN.

"THE GREAT SUPPORT YOU GIVE US THE GREATER WILL BE THE STEPS TO NORMALIZE AGAIN THE POST-JANUARY ROAD."
