

RUSSIANS UNWELCOME

COPENHAGEN, AUG 27 -- (RFE SPECIAL/THOMSON) -- A VISIT TO DENMARK NEXT MONTH BY A DELEGATION OF SOVIET METAL WORKERS HAS BEEN CANCELLED BY THE HOSTS, THE DANISH SMITHS AND METAL WORKERS UNION.

THE DECISION WAS REACHED AT AN EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING IN COPENHAGEN YESTERDAY.

IN A LETTER TO THEIR SOVIET COLLEAGUES, SIGNED BY CHAIRMAN HANS RASMUSSEN, THE DANISH UNION SAID: "... AFTER THE IMPERIALIST POWER POLICY WHICH THE SOVIET UNION TOGETHER WITH OTHER EASTERN POWERS HAS EMBARKED ON WITH THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, WE SEE OURSELVES FORCED TO ANNUL OUR INVITATION AS WE DO NOT WANT TO RISK THE SOVIET DELEGATION BEING SUBJECTED TO OPEN ANGER AND UNPLEASANTRIES DURING THEIR VISIT TO DENMARK. AT THE SAME TIME WE REGRET THE FACT THAT A SOCIALIST STATE HAS TURNED TO METHODS WHICH IN OUR OPINION BELONG TO THE FASCIST DICTATORSHIPS OF THE PAST..."

RUSSIA, CZECHOSLOVAKIA, OTHERS REQUEST DEBATE ON SOUTH KOREA

UNITED NATIONS, AUG. 27, REUTER -- THE SOVIET UNION AND 11 OTHER COUNTRIES HAVE ASKED THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO DEBATE AN ITEM CALLING FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF ALL FOREIGN FORCES FROM SOUTH KOREA, IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY.

CZECHOSLOVAKIA WAS AMONG THE NATIONS WHICH SIGNED THE LETTER REQUESTING THE INSCRIPTION OF THE ISSUE ON THE ASSEMBLY AGENDA. THE LETTER WAS DATED AUGUST 23, TWO DAYS AFTER THE SOVIET-LED INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE LETTER CHARGED THAT AMERICAN MILITARY FORCES IN SOUTH KOREA WERE INCREASING THEIR "PROVOCATIVE ACTIONS" AGAINST NORTH KOREA.

SPONSORS WERE CZECHOSLOVAKIA, BULGARIA, BYELORUSSIA, CAMBODIA, CUBA, HUNGARY, MONGOLIA, POLAND, UKRAINE, SOVIET UNION, SYRIA AND RUMANIA.

HARRIMAN RETURNS TO PARIS

PARIS, AUG 27 (UPI)--U.S. CHIEF NEGOTIATOR W. AVERELL HARRIMAN RETURNED TO PARIS FROM A BRIEF VACATION TODAY FOR WEDNESDAY'S 19TH NEGOTIATING SESSION WITH NORTH VIETNAM.

HARRIMAN, WHO RETURNED FROM FIVE DAYS REST AND RECREATION IN SPAIN, HAD NO COMMENT ON ARRIVAL.

OLYMPIC FLAME IN GENOA

GENOA, ITALY AUG 27 (UPI)--THE OLYMPIC FLAME ARRIVED TODAY IN THIS PORT CITY HOME OF CHRISTOPHER COLUMBUS. THE FLAME WAS BEING HANDED OVER TO ITALIANS WHO WILL CARRY IT OVER COLUMBUS' ROUTE TO THE NEW WORLD AND MEXICO CITY.

NIGERIA DEPORTS THREE RED CROSS WORKERS

LAGOS, NIGERIA AUG 27 (UPI)--THE NIGERIAN GOVERNMENT HAS DEPORTED THREE RED CROSS WORKERS, ONE OF THEM FROM THE ORGANIZATION'S INTERNATIONAL HEADQUARTERS, FOR UNSPECIFIED OFFENCES, IT WAS ANNOUNCED HERE TODAY.

NIGERIAN RED CROSS CHAIRMAN CHIEF ADE OJO, REFUSED TO GIVE ANY FURTHER DETAILS OR IDENTIFY THE THREE, BUT HE WARNED ANY WORKER "MISBEHAVING OR ENGAGING IN SUBVERSION" WILL BE EXPELLED FROM THE COUNTRY WITHIN 24 HOURS.
