C/S -- WESTERN NATIONS OF SECURITY COUNCIL CONFER

UNITED NATIONS, AUG. 27 REUTER - WESTERN NATIONS IN THE U.N. SECURITY COUNCIL CONFERRED BEHIND CLOSED DOORS TODAY ON THE CZECHOSLOVAK CRISIS WITHOUT AGREEING ON WHAT FURTHER ACTION, IF ANY, TO TAKE.

THE COUNCIL WILL REMAIN IN RECESS, WITH MEMBERS AVAILABLE FOR AN URGENT MEETING AT ANY TIME AT THE REQUEST OF THEIR PRESIDENT, DR. JOAO AGUSTO DE ARAUJO CASTRO OF BRAZIL.

DR. CASTRO WAS AMONG THE GROUP THAT DISCUSSED THE QUESTION TODAY. OTHERS PRESENT INCLUDED U.S. AMBASSADOR GEORGE BALL, BRITISH CHIEF DELEGATE LORD CARADON, FRENCH AMBASSADOR ARMAND BERARD, AND THE DELEGATES OF CANADA, DENMARK AND PARAGUAY.
