X/4 C/S -- COMMUNIST LEADERS DISCUSSED CS SITUATION IN MOSCOW, ADN SAYS  
(AMPLIFIES CN 175)

MOSCOW, AUG 27 (CMD)-- THE EAST GERMAN NEWS AGENCY ADN SAID TODAY THAT PARTY AND GOVERNMENT DELEGATIONS FROM BULGARIA, HUNGARY, EAST GERMANY AND POLAND, TOGETHER WITH A SOVIET DELEGATION HEADED BY THE THREE SOVIET LEADERS, HAD MET IN MOSCOW TO DISCUSS, AND <sup>CON</sup>SULT ABOUT, QUESTIONS CONCERNING THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND "UNANIMOUSLY" ADOPTED A CONCLUSION ON THIS QUESTION.

THE NEWS AGENCY DID NOT RPT NOT GIVE ANY DETAILS OF THE CONCLUSION.
