IZVESTIA ADDED: "IT SHOULD BE UNDERSTOOD TO WHOSE MILL THIS BRINGS GRIST."

THE RADIO SAID FURTHER THAT IMPERIALIST PROPAGANDA WAS VERY INTERESTED IN THIS PROBLEM AND IN THE WEST A NEW PROVOCATION CAMPAIGN STARTED, THIS TIME AGAINST RUMANIA.

"IF IT WERE NOT SO, HOW COULD BE EXPLAIN, FOR INSTANCE, THE ASSERTION OF WEST GERMAN FOREIGN MINISTER (WILLY) BRANDT THAT RUMANIA COULD BECOME A VICTIM OF A MILITARY ACTION? IT IS EVIDENT THAT THERE WERE AND THERE ARE NO RPT NO FACTS TO CONFIRM THESE TALE'S," THE RADIO SAID.

"IT WOULD HAVE BEEN NORMAL THAT COMPETENT BUCHAREST CIRCLES GIVE AN IMMEDIATE AND ADEQUATE ANSWER TO THIS INSTIGATING FIB."

"THE FACT THAT THOSE I N BUCHAREST KEPT IN THIS CASE SILENCE IS STRANGE. AND IT IS STILL LESS COMPREHENSIBLE THAT ACCORDING TO SOME STATE MENTS MADE THERE (IN BUCHAREST) OSTENSIBLY THEY ARE READY TO ENCOURAGE THIS FUSS STIRRED UP BY THE ENEMIES OF SOCIALISM."
