IN A COMMENTARY, RADIO DANUBE PLEDGED FULL SUPPORT FOR CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY LEADER ALEXANDER DUBCEK.

SUPPORT FOR DUBCEK WAS ALSO EXPRESSED IN BROADCASTS BY THE RADIO NORTHERN SLOVAKIA TONIGHT (1925).

EMPLOYEES OF THE EASTERN SLOVAK RADIO AND TELEVISION AT KOSICE SAID IN A STATEMENT BROADCAST TONIGHT (1925) THAT THEY HEARD DUBCEK'S ADDRESS TODAY WITH "DEEP EMOTION AND WITH UNDERSTANDING."

"WE UNDERSTOOD WHAT IS OUR DUTY AND WHAT WE MUST DO IN THIS DIFFICULT AND COMPLICATED SITUATION," THE STATEMENT SAID.

"WE UNDERSTAND THAT THERE IS NO RPT NO OTHER WAY OUT. WE WILL NOT RPT NOT DEPART FROM THE POST-JANUARY ROAD. WE WILL NOT RPT NOT BETRAY THE NATION. WE WILL NOT RPT NOT BETRAY THE HOMELAND, WE WILL NOT RPT NOT BETRAY THE PARTY," THE STATEMENT SAID.

A STATEMENT BY THE EMPLOYEES OF RADIO DANUBE TONIGHT (2100) SAID THE EMPLOYEES SUPPORTED THE ATTITUDES WHICH THEY SUPPORTED IN THEIR BROADCASTS UP TO NOW.

"WE ARE CONVINCED THAT THE COMPROMISE THAT EMERGED IN THE MOSCOW NEGOTIATIONS IS AN EXPRESSION OF PRESSURE AGAINST A SMALL, FREE STATE," THE STATEMENT SAID.
