CS - KIESINGER ON MOSCOW COMMUNIQUE.

BONN, AUG. 27, REUTER - WEST GERMAN CHANCELLOR KURT GEORG KIESINGER SAID HERE TODAY THE MOSCOW COMMUNIQUE WAS "NOT EXACTLY PLEASING."

DR KIESINGER WAS QUESTIONED BY JOURNALISTS AS HE ENTERED THE FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE OF THE BUNDESTAG (PARLIAMENT), CALLED INTO SPECIAL SESSION FOLLOWING THE END OF THE MOSCOW TALKS.

HE SAID BRIEFLY "I MUST STUDY THE DOCUMENTS MORE CAREFULLY BUT THEY ARE, OF COURSE, NOT EXACTLY PLEASING." HE REFUSED FURTHER COMMENT.

EARLIER TODAY, THE CHANCELLOR PRESIDED AT A MEETING OF THE DEFENCE COUNCIL. DETAILS OF ITS DECISIONS WERE NOT REVEALED.
