CS - DUTCH LOWER HOUSE CONDEMNS INVASION

THE HAGUE, AUG 28, REUTER--THE DUTCH SECOND CHAMBER (LOWER HOUSE) OF PARLIAMENT YESTERDAY ADOPTED, WITHOUT A DIVISION, A RESOLUTION STRONGLY CONDEMNING THE WARSAW PACT POWERS ATTACK ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND EXPRESSING ITS SOLIDARITY WITH HER PEOPLE.

ONLY THE FIVE-MEMBER COMMUNIST PARTY IN THE 150-MAN HOUSE REGISTERED THEIR DISSENT, THOUGH DURING THE DEBATE THEIR LEADER, MARCUS BAKKER, ALSO DENOUNCED THE ATTACK ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA. HE SAID THE ATTACK WAS "A CONSEQUENCE OF THE REVISIONIST POLICY OF THE SOVIET LEADERSHIP AND A FLAGRANT VIOLATION OF THE PRINCIPLES OF COMMUNISM."
