CS - HUNGARIANS SUPPORTING INVASION, SAYS MTI

BUDAPEST , AUG 28 (UPI) -- THE OFFICIAL HUNGARIAN NEWS SERVICE MTI SAID YESTERDAY THE HUNGARIAN COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE AND GOVERNMENT ARE BEING FLOODED WITH TELEGRAMS "EXPRESSING APPROVAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ASSISTANCE RENDERED TO DEFEAT THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION THAT HAD THREATENED THE SOCIALIST ACHIEVEMENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

IT SAID THE TELEGRAMS CAME FROM "WORKERS AND EMPLOYEES OF HUNGARY'S FACTORIES, AGRICULTURAL COOPERATIVES, OFFICES AND INSTITUTES."

MTI CITED ONE TELEGRAM FROM THE HUNGARIAN NATIONAL MINORITY FEDERATION WHICH SAID THE SOUTHERN SLAV, GERMAN, ROMANIAN AND SLOVAK MINORITIES OF HUNGARY AND THEIR NEWSPAPERS VIEWED THE SOVIET BLOC'S INTERVENTION "WITH APPROVAL AND RELIEF" BECAUSE THEY HAD FELT "GREAT WORRY" OVER EARLIER CZECHOSLOVAK DEVELOPMENTS.
