

X/4/9 C/S WARSAW SAYS C/S LEADERSHIP HAS TO IMPLEMENT MOSCOW DECISIONS

MUNICH, AUG 28 (CMD) -- RADIO WARSAW COMMENTATOR JAN ZAKRZEWSKI SAID TUESDAY NIGHT THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK LEADERSHIP HAS TO FIND THE FORMS AND WAYS OF IMPLEMENTING THE DECISIONS CONTAINED IN THE OFFICIAL COMMUNIQUE ON THE MOSCOW CZECHOSLOVAK-SOVIET TALKS.

"THE OFFICIAL COMMUNIQUE ON THE ENDING OF TALKS IN MOSCOW DOES NOT DETERMINE THE FORMS AND WAYS OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DECISIONS CONTAINED IN THE AGREEMENT, THE IMPLEMENTATION (TO BE CARRIED OUT) BY THE POLITICAL LEADERSHIP OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC.

"IT HAS RETURNED HOME FINDING THE SITUATION WHICH THE MOSCOW DAILY, PRAVDA, DESCRIBES TODAY AS TENSE AND ALARMING," SAID THE COMMENTATOR.

HE ALSO SAID THAT THE CONFLICTING REPORTS CARRIED BY WESTERN NEWS AGENCIES IN RECENT DAYS HAVE CREATED "A SERIOUS CONFUSION" IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AND THEREFORE A RETURN TO THE NORMAL, DISCIPLINED LIFE WILL BE "DIFFICULT".

THE COMMENTATOR SAID THAT "THE QUESTIONS WILL BE ALSO ABOUT THE CAPABILITY OF THE PARTY LEADERSHIPS CONCERNING THE BRINGING UNDER CONTROL OF CERTAIN ELEMENTS WHICH ARE CARRYING OUT AN ACTIVITY WHICH IS NOT COORDINATED, AND DO NOT LISTEN TO THE APPEALS OF THEIR OWN LEADERSHIP."

THE COMMENTATOR REFERRED HERE TO "UNIDENTIFIED RADIO STATIONS BROADCASTING IN CZECH" AND TO THE OPENING OF THE SLOVAK PARTY CONGRESS IN THE CONDITIONS OF "SEMI-LEGALITY" AND THIS DESPITE THE REQUEST OF THE PARTY LEADERSHIP TO POSTPONE THE CONGRESS FOR A TIME WHEN THE PARTY LEADERSHIP WILL BE ABLE TO GO TO BRATISLAVA AND ATTEND THE CONGRESS.
