X/4/9 -- 1ST ADD WARSAW SAYS CS LEADERSHIP

THE COMMENTATOR SAID TELEPHONE CONNECTION BETWEEN PRAGUE AND ABROAD IS AGAIN DIFFICULT, AND THE POLISH RADIO WAS UNABLE TO COMMUNICATE WITH ITS CORRESPONDENT IN PRAGUE FOR THE PAST TWO DAYS.

HE ALSO SAID THAT THE CONTROL OF THE BORDER CROSSING POINTS IS STRICTER SINCE YESTERDAY. HE SAID THAT ONLY CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS RETURNING HOME ARE LET INTO THE COUNTRY..

HE SAID THAT THE AIM OF THIS RESTRICTION IS THE "DESIRE TO PREVENT THE PENETRATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY "UNDESIRABLE ELEMENTS" WHICH MIGHT BE EASY IN THE PERIOD OF "CHAOS."

THE COMMENTATOR SAID THAT THE LEAFLETS WHICH WERE DISTRIBUTED TODAY IN DIFFERENT CZECHOSLOVAK TOWNS, CALLING FOR IGNORING THE UNDERSTANDING REACHED IN MOSCOW, CAN ONLY HINDER THE TASK OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT FOR THE NORMALIZATION OF LIFE IN THE COUNTRY.

THE COMMENTATOR REFERRED TO NEWS AGENCIES REPORTS FROM PRAGUE, WHICH SPOKE ABOUT A NEW CLIMATE OF "SOBER RELAZATION" IN PRAGUE TODAY, AND THE CONSCIOUSNESS THAT "DIFFICULT DAYS" ARE STILL TO COME FOR CZECHOSLOVAKIA.
