

X/4 C/S -- NATIONAL ASSEMBLY FOR DEMOCRATIC DEVELOPMENT

MUNICH, 'AUGUST 28 (CMD) -- CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S NATIONAL ASSEMBLY (PARLIAMENT) HAS RESERVED FOR ITSELF THE RIGHT TO ASSESS GOVERNMENT PROPOSALS IN SUCH A WAY AS TO PRESERVE THE SOVEREIGNTY AND FREEDOM OF THE COUNTRY, RADIO CENTRAL BOHEMIA SAID LAST NIGHT.

THE PARLIAMENT YESTERDAY INTERRUPTED A SESSION WHICH LASTED SEVEN DAYS.

THE RADIO SAID (TEXT):

"A REPORT FROM THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY."

"THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF THE CSSR WORKED FOR THE PAST SEVEN DAYS WITH ALL RESPONSIBILITY AND IN HARMONY WITH THE WILL OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE.

"THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY IS SUPPORTING THE LEGAL BODIES ELECTED BY THE 14TH CONGRESS OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND IS RESPECTING THEM FULLY.

"TODAY IT HEARD THE FIRST PARTIAL INFORMATION OF ITS CHAIRMAN JOSEF SMRKOVSKY WHOM IT CORDIALLY WELCOMED AMONG ITS RANKS. IT CONTINUES TO TRUST HIM FULLY.

"THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF THE CSSR IS RESERVING THE RIGHT IN HARMONY WITH THE CONSTITUTION WITH FULL RESPONSIBILITY TO ASSESS REPORTS AND PROPOSALS OF THE GOVERNMENT IN SUCH A WAY THAT THE SOVEREIGNTY AND FREEDOM OF THE COUNTRY BE PRESERVED, (AND) THAT THE DEMOCRATIC PROCESS OF OUR SOCIALIST REPUBLIC BE CONTINUED FURTHER.

"THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY DECIDED TO INTERRUPT ITS SESSION UNTIL THE TIME WHEN THE GOVERNMENT WILL REPORT AND WILL SUBMIT NECESSARY PROPOSALS." (END TEXT)
