X/4 C/S -- RELEASE OF DISCREDITED SLOVAK LEADERS ASKED
(WITH CN 11 SERIES)

MUNICH, AUG 28 (CMD)-ANTON TAZKY, MEMBER OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY PRESIDIUUM, TOLD THE SLOVAK PARTY CONGRESS YESTERDAY IT WAS NECESSARY TO REMOVE DISCREDITED OFFICIALS FROM THEIR FUNCTIONS IF THEY IN FACT DO NOT RPT NOT CARRY THEM OUT.

TAZKY SAID THE SLOVAK PARTY WILL BE FULLY TRUSTED BY THE SLOVAK PEOPLE ONLY WHEN IT EXPELS THOSE WHO ARE STILL FAVORING "ROTTEN COMPROMISES (IN SLOVAK: PREHNITEMU KOMPROMISNICSTVU)."

TAZKY'S STATEMENT WAS QUOTED BY THE FREE RADIO CENTRAL SLOVAKIA LATE TUESDAY NIGHT.

THE RADIO SAID IT WAS STILL RECEIVING STATEMENTS BY LOWER PARTY ORGANIZATIONS SAYING THEY WERE NOT RPT NOT SATISFIED WITH THE "WORKING" PRESIDIUUM OF THE PARTY CONGRESS.

THESE PARTY ORGANIZATIONS ASKED WHY FOR EXAMPLE PRESIDIUUM CANDIDATE MEMBER MICHAL PECHO AND PRESIDIUUM MEMBER JAN JANIK WERE INCLUDED IN THE PRESIDIUUM.

THEY WANTED TO HEAR ABOUT SLOVAK PARTY LEADER VASIL BILAK WHO, THE RADIO SAID "DOES NOT RPT NOT REPRESENT EVEN A SINGLE SLOVAK STONE".
