THE COMMENTATOR SAID FURTHER THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK-SOVIET TALKS IN CIERNA NAD TISOU AND THE DECISIONS OF THE BRATISLAVA MEETING SHOULD HAVE BECOME A TURNING POINT IN THE STRUGGLE OF THE SOCIALIST FORCES FAITHFUL TO THE IDEAS OF MARXISM-LENINISM AGAINST THE "UNLEASHED ATTACK OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RIGHT WING SUPPORTED STRONGLY BY THE REVISIONISTS OF DIFFERENT KIND."

IN THIS CONNECTION THE COMMENTATOR ATTACKED THE CZECHOSLOVAK MASS MEDIA, WHICH HE SAID, WERE DOMINATED BY FORCES HOSTILE TO SOCIALISM, AND WHICH INSTEAD OF STRENGTHENING THE LEADING ROLE OF THE PARTY HAVE RECOGNIZED THEMSELVES AS THE LEADING FORCES, UNLEASHED AN ALL-ROUND ATTACK AGAINST ALL ORGANIZATIONS, "ORGANS AND ACTIVISTS" DEFENDING SOCIALIST ACHIEVEMENTS, AND PREVENTED ANY PRUDENT VOICE FROM BEING HEARD IN THE PRESS OR RADIO.

THE COMMENTATOR SAID THAT THE TALKS IN CIERNA AND THE BRATISLAVA DECISIONS IMPOSED ON THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY LEADERSHIP AND THE GOVERNMENT THE DUTY OF ENERGETIC OPPOSITION AGAINST THE ACTIONS AIMED AT UNDERMINING THE BASIS OF THE SOCIALIST SYSTEM AND VIOLATING "FRATERNAL ALLIANCES."

THE COMMENTATOR SAID THAT "THE LACK OF AN EFFECTIVE COUNTER-ACTION AGAINST THE GROWING COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY WAVE HAS LED TO A JOINT ACTION OF THE FIVE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES, MEMBERS OF THE WARSAW PACT."

THE COMMENTATOR SAID THAT THIS JOINT ACTION OF FIVE WARSAW PACT COUNTRIES WAS "A BITTER FRUIT FOR ALL COMMUNISTS OF THE SHORT-SIGHTEDNESS AND THE NATIONALIST BLINDNESS OF A PART OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY LEADERSHIP AND THE GOVERNMENT...", HE SAID.
