

TRAVEL AGENTS PROTEST

ANTWERP, AUG 28 REUTER -- A RECEPTION FOR TRAVEL AGENTS DUE TO BE HELD HERE LAST NIGHT ON THE RUSSIAN HYDROFOIL KOMETA WAS CANCELLED BY THE SOVIET TRAVEL BUREAU, INTOURIST, AFTER A BOYCOTT BY SEVERAL AGENTS PROTESTING AGAINST THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

EAST GERMANS HAIL MOSCOW TALKS

EAST BERLIN, AUG 28 REUTER -- THE EAST GERMAN NEWS AGENCY, A.D.N., SAID LAST NIGHT EAST GERMAN WORKERS HAD GREETED THE MOSCOW COMMUNIQUE ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA AS A NOTABLE BLOW AGAINST IMPERIALISM.

THE TEXT OF THE COMMUNIQUE WAS PUBLISHED BY THE AGENCY FROM MOSCOW, BUT NO GOVERNMENT STATEMENT HAS BEEN MADE.

A.D.N. SAID WORKERS ALL OVER THE COUNTRY HAD GREETED THE COMMUNIQUE AS A RESTATEMENT OF THE POWER OF THE WORKING CLASSES AND OF SOCIALISM.

TURKISH TRADE UNIONS BACK C/S PROTESTS

ISTANBUL, TURKEY, AUG 28 (UPI)-THE CONFEDERATION OF TURKISH TRADE UNIONS DECIDED TUESDAY TO BACK ANY STUDENT DEMONSTRATIONS AGAINST THE SOVIET UNION FOR SUPPORTING CZECHOSLOVAKIA BUT NOT TO JOIN PROTESTS AGAINST TURKISH VISITS BY U.S. WARSHIPS.

OFFICIALS OF THE 900,000-MEMBER CONFEDERATION ANNOUNCED THIS DECISION AT A JOINT MEETING WITH STUDENTS AS TURKISH OFFICIALS FLEW 300 RIOT POLICE FROM ANKARA INTO IZMIR IN PREPARATION FOR THE ARRIVAL OF U.S. SIXTH FLEET VESSELS THERE TOMORROW.
