X/4/9 C/S -1ST ADD -- WARSAW SAYS (CN 84) XXX RADIO

THE RADIO SAID FURTHER THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK NATIONAL ASSEMBLY HAD CONDEMNED THE CONCEPT OF NEUTRALIZATION OF THE COUNTRY.

"IT IS EXPECTED THAT A PLENUM OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY WILL CONVENE TODAY OR TOMORROW IN ORDER TO DISCUSS THE RESULTS OF THE MOSCOW TALKS AND PASS AN APPROPRIATE RESOLUTION," SAID THE RADIO.

THE BROADCAST ADDED THAT SOVIET TROOPS HAVE MOVED OUT FROM THE CENTER OF PRAGUE, AND WERE NOW AT SOME POINTS OF SUBURBAN DISTRICTS.
