"IT WAS REPORTED FROM VIENNA, FOR INSTANCE," ZHUKOV'S PRAVDA ARTICLE SAID, "THAT THE WEST GERMAN PATRONS OF CZECHOSLOVAK COUNTER-REVOLUTION RENDERED IT BIG ASSISTANCE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF A NETWORK OF CLANDESTINE RADIO STATIONS.

"IT WAS ASCERTAINED THAT 22 MOBILE RADIO STATIONS, MADE IN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY AND WEST BERLIN, WERE SMUGGLED THROUGH AUSTRIA INTO THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC IN JULY AND AUGUST."

IN ITS REVIEW OF THE MOSCOW PRESS, TASS SAID THAT ALL MORNING NEWSPAPERS PRINTED THE SPEECHES WHICH CZECHOSLOVAK PRESIDENT LUDVIK SVBODA AND PARTY CHIEF ALEXANDER DUBCEK MADE YESTERDAY IN PRAGUE.

TASS DID NOT RPT NOT INDICATE WHETHER THERE WAS ANY COMMENTARY ON THE SPEECHES.
