

C/S - FOREIGN NEWSMEN, TOURISTS BANNED

PRAGUE, AUG 28 (AGENCIES) - THE CZECHOSLOVAK FOREIGN MINISTRY TODAY OFFICIALLY BARRED FOREIGN NEWSMEN MILITARY PERSONNAL AND TOURISTS FROM ENTERING THE COUNTRY "UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE."

THE INFORMATION BULLETIN AS REPORTED BY UPI COMPRISED A FOREIGN OFFICE ANNOUNCEMENT WHICH SAID:

"FOREIGNERS CAN ENTER THE TERRITORY OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC ONLY FOR PURPOSES OF BUSINESS OR OTHER OFFICIAL TRIPS. FOREIGNERS WISHING TO ENTER TO STAY IN SPAS OR FOR OTHER IMPORTANT REASONS MUST, IN ADDITION TO A VISA, HAVE A SPECIAL CERTIFICATE INDICATING THE PURPOSE OF THEIR VISIT:

"JOURNALISTS, WORKERS OF PUBLIC INFORMATION MEDIA, MILITARY PERSONNEL AND TOURISTS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE."
