X/4 C/S - POLISH PRESS HAILS MOSCOW TALKS

MUNICH, AUG 28 (CMD) - PAP REPORTS THAT THE POLISH PRESS TODAY HAILED THE TALKS OF SOVIET-CZECHOSLOVAK LEADERS IN MOSCOW AS CREATING CONDITIONS FOR THE "SUCCESSFUL SOLUTION" OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK CRISIS.

THE POLISH PARTY DAILY TRYBUNA LUDU SAID THE MOSCOW TALKS CREATED CONDITIONS FOR THE "NORMALIZATION OF THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, FOR FINAL REPELLING OF THE ATTACK OF REACTIONARY AND ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES SUPPORTED BY WEST GERMAN AND AMERICAN SUBVERSION CENTRES, AND FOR CONSOLIDATION OF THE UNITY AND COOPERATION OF SOCIALIST COUNTRIES UNITED WITHIN THE WARSAW TREATY."

THE WARSAW NEWSPAPER ZYCIE WARSZAWY ASK WHETHER THE "CZECHOSLOVAK LEADERS WHO PARTICIPATED IN THE MOSCOW TALKS HAVE SUFFICIENT STRENGTH TO CONTROL THE SITUATION AND OPPOSE EFFICIENTLY FURTHER ACTIVIZATION OF THE FORCES STRIVING FOR CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S POLITICAL AND MILITARY BREAKAWAY FROM THE SOCIALIST CAMP?" THE PAPER DESCRIBES THIS AS THE "PARAMOUNT QUESTION WHICH WILL BE ANSWERED IN THE NEAR FUTURE."

THE POLISH ARMY NEWSPAPER ZOLNIERZ WOLNOSCI DECLARED THAT "THE RESULTS OF THE MOSCOW TALKS ARE A POLITICAL SUCCESS OF COMMUNIST AND WORKERS PARTIES OF THE SOCIALIST COMMUNITY."

THE ORGAN OF THE POLISH ARMED FORCES WENT ON TO SAY "OUR FRATERNAL INTERNATIONALIST ASSISTANCE HELPED THE LEADERSHIP OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA REALIZE THE FACT THAT COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY FORCES WERE GROWING IN STRENGTH IN THEIR COUNTRY AND THAT THEY WERE PUSHING CZECHOSLOVAKIA TOWARDS THE CAPITALIST CAMP."
