X/4 C/S --1ST ADD HUSAK: TROOPS COULD LEAVE... (CN 124) XXX AGREEMENT

HUSAK SAID THAT THE ENTIRE CZECHOSLOVAK DELEGATION HAD UNANIMOUSLY AGREED TO "CONCLUDE A HONORARY AGREEMENT WHICH MAKES POSSIBLE THE DEPARTURE OF THE ALLIED TROOPS FROM OUR TERRITORY, THE FULL RENEWAL OF OUR STATE SOVEREIGNTY, OF FREEDOM OF OUR NATIONS AND A POLITICAL DEVELOPMENT ON THE COURSE WHICH WE STARTED IN OUR COUNTRY SINCE JANUARY."

REFERRING TO WHAT HE TERMED VOICES SPREAD BY TRANSMITTERS WHICH SAID THAT "WE MADE COWARDLY COMPROMISES," HUSAK ASKED WHO WANTED TO "LEAD OUR NATIONS INTO A WAR, INTO A FRATRICIDAL WAR, WHO WANTS THOUSANDS OF VICTIMS..."

HUSAK ALSO ASKED: "WHERE ARE THOSE FRIENDS IN THE WORLD WHO KNOW HOW TO CHANGE THE SITUATION IN CENTRAL EUROPE?"

"I AM SAYING VERY RESPONSIBLY THAT THE AGREEMENT WHICH WE HAVE CONCLUDED IS CONSIDERED BY ALL OF US AS HONORABLE, IT IS AN AGREEMENT WHICH IN A VERY BRIEF PERIOD GRANTS PROSPECTS FOR A FULL RESUMPTION OF NORMAL LIFE, FOR A WITHDRAWAL OF THE TROOPS AND FOR OUR OWN SOLUTION OF OUR OWN PROBLEMS," HUSAK DECLARED.
