X/4 C/S --1ST ADD CSSR PARLIAMENT CONSIDERS... (CN 135) XXX COUNTRY

THE PARLIAMENT SAID IN THE FIRST PARAGRAPH OF THE PROCLAMATION THAT IT STILL CONSIDERED THE OCCUPATION OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK REPUBLIC "BY THE TROOPS OF THE FIVE STATES OF THE WARSAW PACT ILLEGAL AND IN CONTRAST TO INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENTS, TO THE UN CHARTER AND TO THE WARSAW AGREEMENT".

THE PARLIAMENT DEMANDED THAT AN "UNDISTURBED FREE ACTIVITY OF ALL CONSTITUTIONAL AND STATE BODIES AND INSTITUTIONS, OF ALL LEGAL COMMUNICATION MEDIA SHOULD BE MADE POSSIBLE AND ENSURED WITHOUT ANY DEALY".

"AT THE SAME TIME WE INSIST THAT ALL OUR CITIZENS WHO ARE STILL BEING ILLEGALLY DETAINED AND ARRESTED BY THE CZECHOSLOVAK AND FOREIGN BODIES AFTER AUG 21 BE RELEASED," THE FIFTH PARAGRAPH SAID.

"THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY STRESSES THAT IT UNSWERVINGLY STICKS TO THE PRINCIPLES AND POLICY PROCLAIMED AND ADOPTED BY THE ACTION PROGRAM OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND BY THE PROGRAM PROCLAMATION OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT," THE PARLIAMENT SAID.
