

X/4 C/S -- RADIO MOSCOW CLAIMS SITUATION IMPROVING

MUNICH, AUG. 28 (CMD) -- RADIO MOSCOW, IN A DOMESTIC BROADCAST THIS MORNING, SAID THERE WERE "CLEAR SIGNS OF AN IMPROVEMENT" IN THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE RADIO SAID ALL "HONEST CZECHS AND SLOVAKS" HAD RECEIVED WITH GREAT SATISFACTION THE "SUCCESS OF THE MOSCOW NEGOTIATIONS."

IT ADDED:

"THE RESULTS OF THE FRANK, COMRADELY NEGOTIATIONS IN MOSCOW CAN ALREADY BE FELT THROUGHOUT THE TOWNS AND VILLAGES OF THE COUNTRY.

"PARTY AND STATE ORGANS ARE TAKING STEPS TO RESTORE ORDER AND ARE ORGANIZING MUNICIPAL TRANSPORT. THE WALLS OF BUILDINGS ARE BEING CLEARED OF PROVOCATIVE POSTERS AND INSCRIPTIONS."

HOWEVER, THE RADIO CONTINUED, "THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT THE COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES HAVE GIVEN UP THE STRUGGLE.

"BUT NOW ALL FRIENDS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA RE CONFIDENT THAT ITS WORKING PEOPLE, LED BY ITS COMMUNIST PARTY, WILL BE ABLE TO GET TO THE BOTTOM OF THE PRESENT COMPLEX SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY AND DEAL A CRUSHING BLOW TO THE ENEMIES OF SOCIALIST CZECHOSLOVAKIA."
