ANOTHER PAPER, MAGYAR HIRLAP, SAID COMMENTING ON THE MOSCOW ACCORD, THAT IT HAD MATERIALIZED "AS THE TWO PARTNERS IN NEGOTIATIONS AND ALSO THE OTHERS PRESENT IN CONSULTATIONS FOR THIS PURPOSE DESIRED THE DEVELOPMENT OF SOCIALISM, BECAUSE BOTH PARTIES SINCERELY SOUGHT A WAY OUT OF THE PRESENT SITUATION."

THE PATRIOTIC PEOPLE'S FRONT DAILY "MAGYAR NEMZET" WROTE THAT " THE SITUATION IN THE CSSR WAS NOT RPT NOT WITHOUT THE ELEMENTS OF A SERIOUS TENSION," THAT THE MOSCOW NEGOTIATIONS "COULD NOT RPT NOT REMOVE THIS TENSION, STILL LESS THE CAUSES OF THIS TENSION..."

IT SAID "A QUICK CONSOLIDATION DEPENDS ON THE TEMP AND WEIGHT WITH WHICH THE MEASURES TO SERVE THE FURTHER DEVELOPMENT OF THE SOCIALIST SYSTEM, THE LEADING ROLE OF THE PARTY, THE FRIENDLY RELATIONS WITH THE USSR AND THE OTHER SOCIALIST COUNTRIES WILL BE EFFICIENTLY APPLIED."
