THESE ATTITUDES WERE EMPHASIZED AGAIN IN THE SPEECHS OF THE RUMANIAN LEADERS DURING THEIR RECENT VISITS TO SEVERAL DISTRICTS OF TRANSYLVANIA, CARRIED BY RUMANIAN PAPERS TODAY.

THE RUMANIAN VICE-PREMIER OF THE HUNGARIAN NATIONALITY, JANOS FAZEKAS AT A RALLY HELD IN THE TOWN OF ORDEHEJUL CATEG<sup>O</sup>RICALLY REJECTED THE WRITINGS OF THE PAPERS OF HUNGARY AND OTHER COUNTRIES IN WHICH THE RUMANIAN PARTY AND ITS LEADERSHIP WERE ACCUSED OF NATIONALISM.

THE VIOLATION OF INDEPENDENCE AND SOVEREIGNTY OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE WAS CONDEMNED NOT ONLY BY THE RUMANIAN PEOPLE BUT BY THE HUNGARIANS IN RUMANIA AND OTHER NATIONALITIES, FAZEKAS SAID.

THE HEAD OF THE RUMANIAN PARTY AND STATE, CEAUSESCU, ON HIS PART EMPHASIZED AGAIN AT THE RALLY THAT RUMANIA WISHES A WIDE COOPERATION WITH ALL, BUT THAT NOBODY OUTSIDE CAN ASSESS HOW PROBLEMS IN SOME COUNTRIES SHOULD BE SETTLED.

RUMANIA IS READY TO MEET HER OBLIGATIONS IN THE ALLIANCES WITH THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES IF AN IMPERIALIST ATTACK TAKES PLACE, BUT THAT SHE IS ALSO FIRMLY RESOLVED NOT TO LET ANYBODY TO INTERFERE INTO HER INTERNAL MATTERS AND TO TRAMPLE HER SOVEREIGNTY, CEAUSESCU ADDED.
