

X/4 CS - BORBA ATTACKS ZHIVKOV OVER CZECHOSLOVAKIA

BELGRADE, AUG 28 (CMD)- THE YUGOSLAV COMMUNIST PARTY PAPER BORBA TODAY ATTACKED BULGARIAN PARTY-GOVERNMENT LEADER TODOR ZHIVKOV, SAYING HE AND OTHER BULGARIAN LEADERS HAD LEARNED NOTHING FROM PAST EXPERIENCE.

AS REPORTED BY TANJUG, BORBA SAID ZHIVKOV AND OTHER BULGARIAN LEADERS FREQUENTLY CHANGED THEIR ATTITUDES TOWARD "SUBSTANTIAL QUESTIONS" IN THE FIELD OF SOCIALISM AND RELATIONS IN THE INTERNATIONAL LABOR MOVEMENT.

"TO BE FRIENDS WITH CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AND LATER TO OCCUPY HER AND LATER AGAIN TO WITHDRAW TROOPS, IT IS QUITE NORMAL FOR THEM (THE BULGARIAN LEADERS)," BORBA SAID. "TO SLANDER YUGOSLAVIA AND THEN FRATERNIZE WITH HER LATER AND THEN INSULT HER AND THEN AGAIN TO OFFER THE HAND OF FRIENDSHIP AS IF NOTHING HAPPENED."

BORBA SAID THAT ZHIVKOV HAD ATTACKED YUGOSLAVIA FOR ITS SUPPORT OF THE "LEGAL LEADERSHIP OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA" IN A SPEECH WRITTEN FOR A RALLY AT AGLIKINA POLANA. IT SAID ZHIVKOV HAD "BUREAUCRATIC AND STATIST CONCEPTIONS ON SOCIALISM AND RELATIONS IN THE INTERNATIONAL LABOR MOVEMENT."

IT ADDED:

"ZHIVKOV AND THE BULGARIAN LEADERSHIP HAVE LEARNED NOTHING FROM THE PAST. HOWEVER, NEITHER ZHIVKOV NOR RPT NOR ANYBODY ELSE IS ENTITLED TO IMPOSE HIS IDEAS OF SOCIALISM ON ANOTHER SOCIALIST COUNTRY." (TANJUG, AUG 28)
