HE WENT ON TO SAY THAT THE GOVERNMENT IS PREPARING MEASURES ON SOLVING THE CONSEQUENCES OF THE PRESENT SITUATION.

THE GOVERNMENT, CERNIK SAID, WOULD SOON WORK OUT A DOCUMENT WHICH WOULD BE ADDRESSED TO THE FIVE ALLIED COUNTRIES, THE SOVIET UNION, BULGARIA, POLAND, HUNGARY AND EAST GERMANY.

IT WAS THE GOVERNMENT'S AIM TO ACHIEVE THE GRADUAL WITHDRAWAL OF THE FOREIGN TROOPS.

HE ALSO SAID THAT THE "STRENGTHENING OF SOCIALISM IN OUR COUNTRY REMAINS AN INTERNAL AFFAIR OF OUR COUNTRY."
