X/4 EURO -- YUGOSLAV CENTRAL COMMITTEE SESSION

BELGRADE, AUGUST 28 (CMD)-- THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF YUGOSLAVIA'S LEAGUE OF COMMUNISTS MET IN BELGRADE TODAY AND TANJUG SAID THAT COMMUNIST REPRESENTATIVES OF THE PEOPLE'S ARMY HAD ATTENDED THE SESSION.

IN A BRIEF REPORT TONIGHT, TANJUG, THE OFFICIAL YUGOSLAV NEWS AGENCY, ALSO SAID THAT REPRESENTATIVES OF THE YUGOSLAV SOCIALIST ALLIANCE, OF THE TRADE UNION CONFEDERATION, THE YUGOSLAV YOUTH UNION AND OF THE GOVERNMENT HAD PARTICIPATED IN THE SESSION.

TANJUG SAID THE MEETING WAS HELD UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SECRETARY OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE, MIJALKO TODOROVIC.

THE NEWS AGENCY WENT ON TO SAY THAT THE MEETING HAD DISCUSSED "CURRENT QUESTIONS OF CARRYING OUT THE RESOLUTION OF THE TENTH MEETING OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE AND THE GUIDELINES OF THE PRESIDUM AND THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE..."

(CMD-- THE TENTH SESSION OF THE YUGOSLAV PARTY'S CENTRAL COMMITTEE, LAST FRIDAY, DESCRIBED "AS FULLY UNACCEPTABLE ALL ARGUMENTS PRESENTED BY THE FIVE COUNTRIES OF THE WARSAW TREATY AIMED AT JUSTIFYING THEIR INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.")
