

X/4 C/S -- CERNIK, SVOBODA APPEAL TO JOURNALISTS

MUNICH, AUGUST 28 -- (CMD)-- CZECHOSLOVAK PRESIDENT LUDVIK SVOBODA AND PREMIER OLDRICH CERNIK TODAY APPEALED TO JOURNALISTS OF THE PRESS, RADIO AND TELEVISION AGAIN TO PUT THEMSELVES AT THE DISPOSAL OF THE PEOPLE.

RADIO CENTRAL BOHEMIA SAID TONIGHT THAT CERNIK MET JOURNALISTS AT THE PRAGUE CASTLE TODAY AND THAT SVOBODA APPEARED FOR A SHORT TIME AMONG THE JOURNALISTS.

"BOTH STATESMEN ACQUAINTED THE JOURNALISTS WITH THE RESULTS OF NEGOTIATIONS OF OUR REPRESENTATIVES IN MOSCOW," THE RADIO SAID.

"THE PRIME MINISTER THEN REPLIED TO NUMEROUS QUESTIONS OF THOSE PRESENT.

"AT THE SAME TIME BOTH OUR HIGHEST REPRESENTATIVES APPEALED TO ALL WORKERS OF THE PRESS, RADIO AND TELEVISION, IN FULL CONFIDENCE IN OUR LEGAL REPRESENTATIVES AND IN THE FIRM BELIEF IN THE POSSIBILITY, EVEN IN THE PRESENT SITUATION TO AIM AT THE FULFILMENT OF THE JANUARY EFFORTS AND THE PROGRAMMATIC DECLARATION OF THE GOVERNMENT AGAIN TO PUT ALL THEIR STRENGTH INTO THE SERVICE OF THE PEOPLE."
