

U.N. CZECHOSLOVAK MISSION PUBLISHED NATIONAL ASSEMBLY DECLARATION P-12, UNITED NATIONS, AUGUST 28 (RFE SPECIAL/ENDRST)--THE CZECHOSLOVAK MISSION TO THE U.N. WEDNESDAY PUBLISHED THE DECLARATION OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY IN PRAGUE DENOUNCING THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE MISSION DISTRIBUTED A PRESS RELEASE CONTAINING THE EIGHT-POINT DECLARATION, NOTING THAT IT WAS ADOPTED UNANIMOUSLY.

OTHERWISE THERE WAS NO COMMENT BY THE MISSION.

KLAUS FUCHS APPROVES CSSR INVASION

BERLIN, AUG 28, (UPI)-- ATOMIC SPY KLAUS FUCHS TODAY SAID IT WAS AN "UNDERSTANDABLE OBLIGATION" OF THE RUSSIANS TO INTERVENE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

"IT IS GOOD THAT THE TANKS OF THE ALLIED SOCIALIST ARMIES TOOK UP POSITIONS IN TIME BEFORE THE COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES COULD START A BLOODBATH," HE SAID IN A STATEMENT DISTRIBUTED BY THE EAST GERMAN NEWS SERVICE ADN.

FUCHS IS DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF THE EAST GERMAN NUCLEAR RESEARCH STATION AT ROSSENDORF, NEAR DRESDEN.

LONDON - PRAGUE COMMUNICATIONS RESTORED

LONDON, AUG 28, REUTER - TELEPHONE, TELEGRAM AND TELEX SERVICES BETWEEN LONDON AND PRAGUE WERE RESTORED TODAY AFTER A FIVE-DAY BREAK.

ABOUT 200 TELEPHONE CALLS WERE WAITING AND THERE WAS AN INDEFINITE DELAY, SAID A POST OFFICE SPOKESMAN HERE.

KENYA RADIO CONDEMNS INVASION OF CSSR

NAIROBI, AUG 28 REUTER--THE STATE VOICE OF KENYA RADIO AND TELEVISION STATION TONIGHT BROADCAST A STRONG ATTACK AGAINST THE TERMS RUSSIA IMPOSED BEFORE AGREEING TO WITHDRAW ITS TROOPS FROM CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

IN A COMMENTARY THE STATION SAID: "THE KREMLIN HAS ORDAINED THAT CZECHOSLOVAKIA SHALL ENJOY FREEDOM BEHIND BARBED WIRE."

THE BROADCAST ADDED: "THE PEOPLE AND THE GOVERNMENT OF KENYA STRICTLY ADHERE TO THEIR POLICY OF NON-ALIGNMENT. BUT THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT THEY CONDONE THE EVIL INCLINATIONS OF ANY POWER BLOC."
