

WEST BERLIN PUPILS DEMONSTRATE FOR CZECHOSLOVAKA  
BERLIN, AUG 28 (RFE SPECIAL/WULFF) -- SEVERAL THOUSAND WEST  
BERLIN PUPILS ARE HOLDING A MARCH THROUGH WEST BERLIN THIS AFTERNOON  
LEADING FROM DOWNTOWN WITTENBERG PLATZ TO OLIVAER PLATZ TO EXPRESS THEIR  
SYMPATHY WITH THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE.

THE MARCH WAS ARRANGED BY WEST BERLIN PUPILS' AND TEACHERS'  
ORGANIZATIONS.

THE YOUNG PEOPLE CARRIED POSTERS WITH THEM SAYING "USSR --  
GET OUT OF PRAGUE -- U.S.A. -- GET OUT OF VIETNAM" AND  
"AGAINST CAPITALISM AND STALINISM."

LEFTIST PUPILS' GROUPS DISTRIBUTED LEAFLETS POINTING OUT THAT  
THIS WAS NOT RPT NOT AN ANTI-COMMUNIST DEMONSTRATION BUT A  
DEMONSTRATION DIRECTED AGAINST "SOVIET IMPERIALISM."

THE YOUNG PEOPLE SHOUTED "SVOBODA" AND "DUBCEK" RHYTHMICALLY  
WHILE MARCHING THROUGH THE STREETS.

PRAGUE TRAMCAR ARRIVES DESPITE THE INVASION  
LONDON AUGUST 28--(RFE SPECIAL/HOOD)--PRAGUE  
TRAMCAR NO. 180, WHICH LEFT THE CZECHOSLOVAK CAPITAL  
A FEW HOURS BEFORE THE RUSSIAN INVASION, BOUND FOR AN  
ENGLISH MUSEUM, ARRIVED AT FELIXSTOWE LAST NIGHT  
AFTER ITS EVENTFUL JOURNEY.

THE FIVE CZECHOSLOVAK ENGINEERS ACCOMPANYING IT  
ON THE TRANSPORTER DECIDED TO CARRY ON WITH DELIVERY OF  
THE GIFT FROM THE PRAGUE COMPANY "CKD TATRA" TO  
THE TRAMWAY MUSEUM AT CRICH IN DERBYSHIRE.

ZDENEK BURIAN, THE TECHNICAL ENGINEER IN CHARGE,  
TOLD NEWSMEN AT THE PORT:

"MY JOB NOW IS TO DELIVER THE TRAM TO CRICH.  
THEN I SHALL BE VERY HAPPY AND SO WILL ALL THE PEOPLE IN  
PRAGUE WHO HAVE WORKED ON HER RESTORATION."

FORMER FOREIGN SECRETARY GEORGE BROWN WILL GIVE  
THE CZECHOSLOVAKS A VOTE OF THANKS AT THE FORMAL PRESENTATION  
CEREMONY ON SUNDAY.
